In my kitchen, I use them on the dishwasher's power button and on the microwave oven's "one minute" and power level buttons. On the TV remote control I have bumps on the power, volume, and "channel up" buttons. Meanwhile, I've used the paint pens to create high marks on my VCR remote control and to draw raised lines on my coffee carafe at the levels I frequently use.
